Philippians 1:3-8

Dr. Arnold talked about the Gallup International Millennium Survey. Each of the 60,000 respondents was asked the question, “What matters most in life?” How would you respond to that question?

Take 15 minutes or so to talk to God about one of the questions below.

You might find it helpful to journal through one of these.

- 1) What place does sharing the gospel currently have in your life? What place would you like it to have?
- 2) Sharing the Gospel is an act of love and reflects God’s redemptive love for the world. Sometimes we are reluctant to share the gospel because—if we were really honest with ourselves—we would realize that we fall desperately short of the love that God has for people. This kind of love is truly supernatural and does not come from within. It comes to us from God through his Spirit. Spend some time praying that God would increase your capacity to love.
- 3) What is your major? What is your career path? What are some creative (and potentially effective) ways of using your discipline and career as a vehicle for representing Christ’s love and sharing the gospel? Pray and ask God to show you some ways to do this.
- 4) Have you ever given your money to support someone who is devoting his or her life (or a short term of his or her lives) to spreading the gospel? Ask God to show you if you should partner with someone in the year ahead.
